What is an Ecolodge?

An Eco lodge accommodation is an accommodation baring the Gîtes de France label built with low environmental impact methods. This concept uses knowledge in economics, functioning of the ecosystem and bio construction. It emphasizes the origin and the nature of materials made from renewable resources, thus being the least energy-consuming and least polluting possible.



Our Eco lodge, built in 2011, is a low energy-consuming building made of 36.5 cm Siporex. Very few fossil fuels were used. The hot water and the heating are provided by solar energy in addition to a wood-burning heater.

Waste sorting is set up using composting, a farmyard and recycling.

Water management is no concern here in the mountains for the while but we plan on limiting water consumption by using adapted devices.

Far from it all: This area is still spared from the extensive tourism which tends to stay on the coast. As a result, our region is still exceptionally authentic and unspoilt, as we intend to keep it. With the red stones and blue skies, our mountains offer a unique perspective in Europe. Located near the National Park of the Mercantour, our area is protected by the Natura 2000 Network: currently it ranks amongst some of the most significant natural protected sites in Europe.
